## The Problem

- ▶ General Practice is under huge strain - in the East of England specifically, 35% of General Practices are short on GPs and have been unable to fill vacancies in the last 12 months.
- ▶ Across the CCG patch 4 in 10 patients eligible for an Annual Health Check do NOT get one.
- ▶ All the relevant scientific studies consistently report that LD health checks lead to detection of unmet, unrecognised and potentially treatable health needs

- ▶ CCG-wide programme to up-skill your practice nurse or nurse practitioner to complete the LD Annual Health Check thereby ensuring our patients get the check they need.
