NHS East of England Eating Disorders Clinical Network Annual Conference is being held at the Hallmark Hotel, Bar Hill, near Cambridge, on 4th December 2018.

This conference is for those who may encounter people with an eating disorder, e.g. schools, GPs, nurses in acute hospitals, as well as those working in voluntary, community and in-patient services with/for eating disorders.

The day's content is also relevant to service users and carers, and covers all ages. Our keynote is being presented by Dr Dasha Nicholls who is Consultant Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist at Great Ormond Street Hospital and Honorary Senior Lecturer at the Institute of Child Health, University College London.
