### **Job Purpose**

Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Training Hub are looking for an experienced local GP to lead on the development and implementation of a range of activities and support aimed at attracting and retaining GPs to Cambridgeshire and Peterborough. Building on the successful launch by the CCG of the GP Support Hub in 2019, we are seeking a GP to help grow our offering and create a programme for 2019/20 and beyond.

The GP Support Hub is a brand name for a suite of products and support aimed at attracting, retaining and developing GP's in varying stages of their career from those in their first five years of career (First 5), to those in the middle of their career (Mid-career), to those entering their last five years of practice (wise5).

The successful candidate will be an appropriately qualified GP on the UK Medical Performer's List and working within Cambridgeshire and Peterborough and will be able to commit to one 3.5 hour session per week paid at £285 per session for the next 12-18 months.

The GP Support Hub Lead will work as part of the Training Hub team that includes a Project Manager, GP Clinical Chair and dedicated Project Support Officer.

### **Main Duties & Responsibilities**

- Working with the Training Hub, providing clinical leadership and development of the GP Support Hub offering to GP's across the county.
- Help inform, shape, co-ordinate and develop services, strategies and initiatives aimed at improving retention and recruitment of GPs
- Support current networks and promote growth of new GP Peer Support Networks (Mid-Career, Locum and Wise 5) across Cambridge, Huntingdon and Peterborough.
- Work closely with the three First 5 GP leads in Cambridge, Huntingdon and Peterborough providing support, mentoring and oversight of local First 5 projects.
- Work with the local Vocational Training Schemes (VTS) Leads, First 5 leads and the GP Appraisal Network to inform the development of a GP retention strategy for Cambridgeshire and Peterborough
- Keep up to date with national policy around GP workforce issues and help the training hub to disseminate relevant updates across networks;
- Inform the Training Hub of local developments and initiatives to feedback to the CCG/STP.
