Contact Local Pharmacy

Ring community pharmacies local to the patient to discuss availability of medicines.

Contact pharmacies that are contracted to provide services under the Palliative Care Scheme

Where local pharmacies do not hold stock to fulfil the FP10 designated palliative care pharmacies should be contacted.

Medicines held in stock are posted above

Opening hours of these pharmacies are posted above

LAST RESORT where URGENT EOL medication is needed

Where a medicine is required urgently for an end-of-life care patient and cannot be obtained from pharmacies across Cambridgeshire and Peterborough, as a last resort the local acute Trusts pharmacy departments will supply medication against an FP10.
