6. Workforce

Winter planning

- Roll out of additional flu planning clinics
- Focus on complex cases and their families
 - CYP shielding withdrawal
 - Risk stratification
 - Fit mask testing for AGPs
- Working with community paediatricians to keep CYP out of hospital and managed in the community
- 7 day CCN service

SEND

- WSOA for Peterborough – joint commissioning
- Education health care plans – impact of therapy services / social communication / SEMH
- Returning to school in September
 - Anxieties
 - PPE
 - Safeguarding issues

LD/ASD / CYPMH

- Planning returns – working with Marek and his team to capture additional requirements and surge preparation
- Trauma focussed support / ACE requirements
- Increased anxiety / depression / bereavement
- Back log of face to face impacting on waiting lists
- risk analysis of waiting lists
- Demand and capacity planning
- reducing numbers of CYP in in- patient units – development of a key worker model / increased support to crisis services/ ED services
- Procurement of a lead provider model to deliver single point of referral and third sector support for early interventions.

Maternity

- Roll out of continuity of carer at CUH – LTP requirement
- MH planning around perinatal MH increase
- BAME communities
- Baby Boom !

Workforce

- Business continuity plans
- Contingency planning for local outbreaks or 2nd wave of covid
- Small workforce in comparison to adults .
