Service Requirements and Payments**

PCN DES Service Requirements

The EOI will detail the requirements of the PCN DES services that are to be provided to the patients of Monkfield Medical Practice:

- Social prescribing service
- From 1 April 2022 until 30 September 2022, the extended hours access
- From 1 April 2022 until 30 September 2022 the preparatory requirements for Enhanced Access
- From 1 October 2022, the Enhanced Access requirements
- The Medication Review and Medicines Optimisation requirements
- The Enhanced Health in Care Homes requirements
- The Early Cancer Diagnosis requirements
- The Cardiovascular Disease (CVD) Prevention and Diagnosis requirements
- The Tackling Neighbourhood Health Inequalities requirements
- The Anticipatory Care requirements
- The Personalised Care requirements

Payments for PCN DES Services

Payments for PCN DES services are calculated with reference, where appropriate, to the registered patient size of the non-DES practice. These payments reflect:

- Core PCN funding
- Extended hours access
- Enhanced access
- Care homes premium
- Clinical director funding; and
- Leadership and management payment
- Additional Roles Reimbursement (ARRS) funding

Monkfield Medical Practice will not be entitled to the Network Participation Payment if not participating in the Network Contract DES.
